

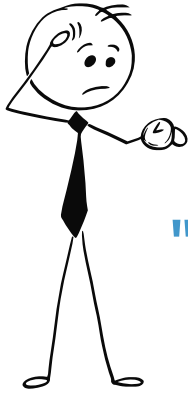
THE "YET" IS
